


ESPE e-learning web portal

The ESPE e-learning web portal is an interactive learning environment for up to date topics in paediatric endocrinology. Through this free web portal medical students, fellows, specialists and tutors around the world can share, contribute and develop knowledge in an accessible and flexible way. Membership of ESPE or any other sister society is NOT required for using the portal and there are NO fees for usage of this portal.

To join the ESPE e-learning learning website, please follow the steps in this manual, and you will be granted access to the portal.

Step 1: Registration procedure

- Open the web address: www.espe-elearning.org
- Click the "Login" button at the top-right, and then on the login page click "New account registration" (red circles)
- Choose your own "Username", e.g. your email address, and choose a "Password".
Allowed characters: A-Z a-z 0-9 _ . + ? # - * @ ! \$ % ~ / ;
(please write it down your for you will need it each visit)
- Fill out all the remaining required fields in the form, and accept the "User agreement".
- Click "Register" to finalise the registration
- You will receive an e-mail with instructions:
"... activate your account and confirm ownership of this email address, click the link below..."



Step 2: Accessing content

- Log in
- From the list of "Categories" choose the category of your liking; General Content learning modules
- Resource Limited Countries learning modules
- For Student Courses: from the displayed list choose the learning group *Growth and Puberty [Student]*
